I strongly believe in budgeting and will take on the responsibility of overseeing the BMV's money seriously. I will be totally responsible for monitoring all banking transactions.

2. How will you ensure that all laws, rules, guidelines and procedures are followed, at all times, specifically with regard to issuing and renewing driver's licenses, identification cards, and vehicle registrations?

I will continue to review and implement all the changes, rules and regulations that come to us on a daily basis and make sure my staff is following all procedures. I will be reviewing and signing off on all BMV 5745s and remain especially alert with our foreign customers ensuring they have all documents required before issuing Ohio drivers' licenses and/or state i.d. cards.

3. What measures will you put in place to detect, deter, and prevent fraud?

Each employee is now required to take the Fraud Doc 1 & 2 training tests. Also the employee handbook must be reviewed and signed with the understanding of the importance of detecting and preventing fraud. Employees also will be constantly monitored and tills audited at various unannounced times. Cameras are installed to monitor the entire office.

4. The Bureau of Motor Vehicles routinely issues new and/or revised policy and procedural changes through email broadcasts to the deputy registrars. How will you ensure that policies and procedures are communicated to the staff and followed on a daily basis?

Staff are required to read, review and initial each broadcast upon receipt. If there are questions, they are required to ask and I will explain and review with them until we all have complete understanding of the new rule/regulation.

5. How will you demonstrate good leadership to your employees?

I will continue to lead by example especially during peak hours. I will show my employees that teamwork does work when we do things together. One person cannot achieve when alone but when we conducts ourselves together as one unit, we can achieve great things. I will be courteous and pleasant to our customers (phone and in person) and my staff. I will ensure that we all maintain integrity and serve with an excellent spirit.

6. How will you maintain a high level of professionalism each day in this business?

By continuing exemplary customer service that I have been taught over my years of experience with the BMV. Continue to have a pleasant attitude, appearance (office casual) and decrease interoffice gossip. We will respect each other and our customers daily. I will also continue to be a problem solver to the best of my ability. We will remain professional and continue to help and serve BMV public.

7. How do you intend to recruit and retain high quality employees?

I would like to work with other DRs and share part time employees that would like to have more hours but aren't able to get the hours at their current agency. This can benefit both agencies because there are now experienced employees and they can receive additional hours. I intend to open the Warren location with 3 full time employees and 2 part time employees. All of the employees who are currently there are willing to remain there.

Throughout the day we will clean and sanitize the counters, vision screeners, PODS, terminals, supply shelves, chairs and printers. The bathrooms will be attended to on a daily basis. We will vacuum and sweep daily. We will mop the floors as needed. Outside maintenance is provided by the plaza owners. We will have a window cleaner to keep windows clean. However my staff and I will sweep outside of our workplace as needed.

9. How would you deal with an irate customer?

My first goal is to always be helpful and of service. I try to listen first and try to get them to calm down. Most problems are easily solved once the customer comes out of "panic" or "anger" mode and realizes that we have their best interest at heart. I can usually tell a customer what the BMV requirements are and though they don't like the outcome sometimes, they usually understand. The heavily irate customer is dismissed professionally and we provide them with phone numbers and apologize that we couldn't service them to their satisfaction. However, I advise my staff not to go back and forth with anyone and to always come and get me if the situation escalates as strife doesn't solve anything.

The deputy registrar need not list any salary or wages for the deputy's own service as deputy registrar or as the office manager.
