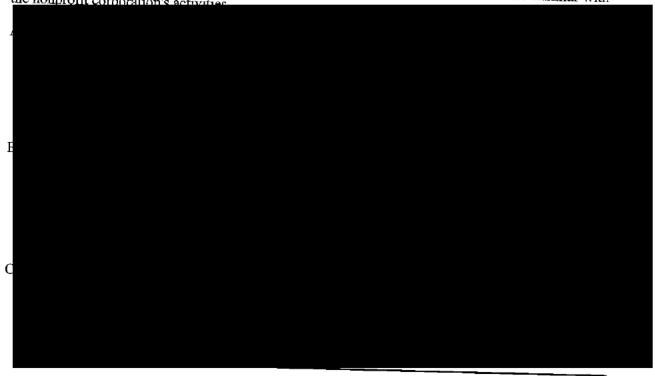

1. How do you plan to manage, be responsible, and be accountable for this business at all times?

We foster a culture of accountability by holding the team responsible for results based on BMV performance standards. Our annual strategic plan focuses on three success pillars: Pillar 1—improving customer service, Pillar 2—achieving a 90%+ agency review, and Pillar 3—ensuring financial sustainability. Weekly performance reviews ensure accountability and progress toward these pillars, driving ongoing success.

2. How will you ensure that all laws, rules, guidelines and procedures are followed, at all times, specifically with regard to issuing and renewing driver's licenses, identification cards, and vehicle registrations?

Train, Verify, Observe, Audit. Managers ensure compliance with Ohio BMV laws and procedures, holding the team accountable for their roles. Compliance training begins on day one of onboarding, covering BMV policies and procedures. Experienced managers closely observe clerks' progress toward transactional proficiency. Driver's Licenses and State IDs are double-checked for accuracy by managers before submission. Additionally, applications are audited daily for errors to ensure ongoing compliance and accuracy in all transactions.

3. What measures will you put in place to detect, deter, and prevent fraud?

Train, Verify, Observe, Audit. We implement a robust strategy: employees undergo Fraud 1 and 2 training, and supervisors verify transactions for accuracy. Managers observe clerks and conduct daily spot checks. Regular audits and monthly reviews ensure compliance. Security cameras monitor all stations. We establish clear performance standards and hold employees accountable, taking corrective action when necessary. This multi-layered approach ensures early detection and prevention, safeguarding the integrity of our operations.

4. The Bureau of Motor Vehicles routinely issues new and/or revised policy and procedural changes through email broadcasts to the deputy registrars. How will you ensure that policies and procedures are communicated to the staff and followed on a daily basis?

Train, Verify, Observe, Audit. Managers are held accountable to monitor the BMV email broadcasts daily. Emails are printed out when a new broadcast has arrived. All BMV staff are held accountable to check the Broadcast Book and initial during our daily team huddles. Managers explain and train the new content to insure understanding. Managers then observe clerks work to verify compliance to the new updates. Monthly audits of changes are made by managers to insure compliance. The manager reviews the book weekly to make sure it is up to date and the staff have reviewed the broadcasts.

5. How will you demonstrate good leadership to your employees?

Lead by example. Effective leadership begins with caring for the individual and accepting responsibility for their performance. When individuals feel valued and appreciated, they will perform at a high level. We established a high standard of customer care. The team understands and respects the standard. At times some will test the standards of care, wanting to compromise the standard. Anything that disrupts family (team) stability or team unity is dealt with immediately with fair and appropriate discipline.

6. How will you maintain a high level of professionalism each day in this business?

By establishing a high standard of care and ensuring that everyone understands and respects the standard. Our standard of care is an exceptional customer experience, -caring for other as we want to be cared for. We inspect what we expect by observing and hold each employee to the standard. At times some will want to compromise the standard. Any behavior that compromise the standard is dealt with immediately with fair and appropriate discipline.

7. How do you intend to recruit and retain high quality employees?

We successfully use online job boards like Indeed and employee referrals to hire qualified candidates, such as our new hires and interim manager. To retain employees, we offer training, growth opportunities, and family-friendly benefits like Paid Time Off. Employees can also earn variable compensation through sales. We invest in improving our culture, managerial skills, and work environment, ensuring ongoing development and support for our team.

8. How will you provide a safe, clean and friendly place to do business?
